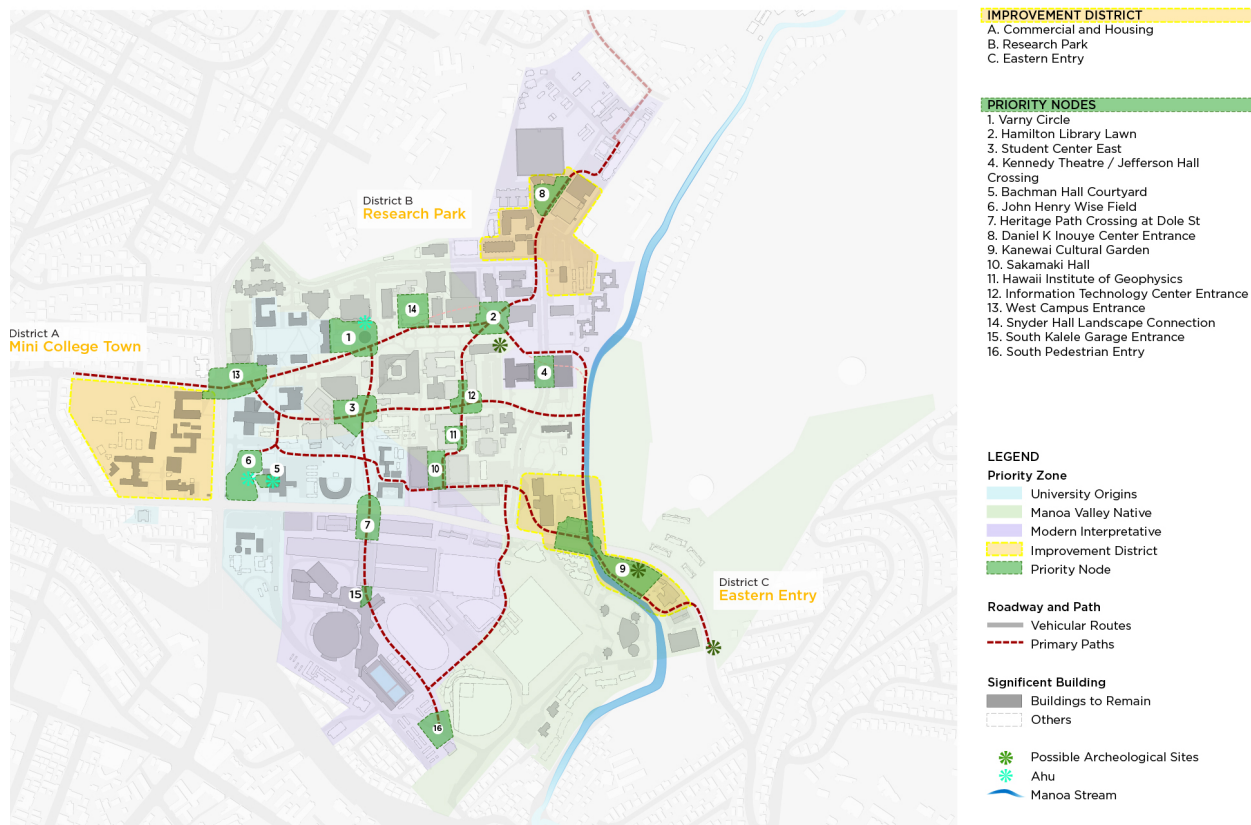

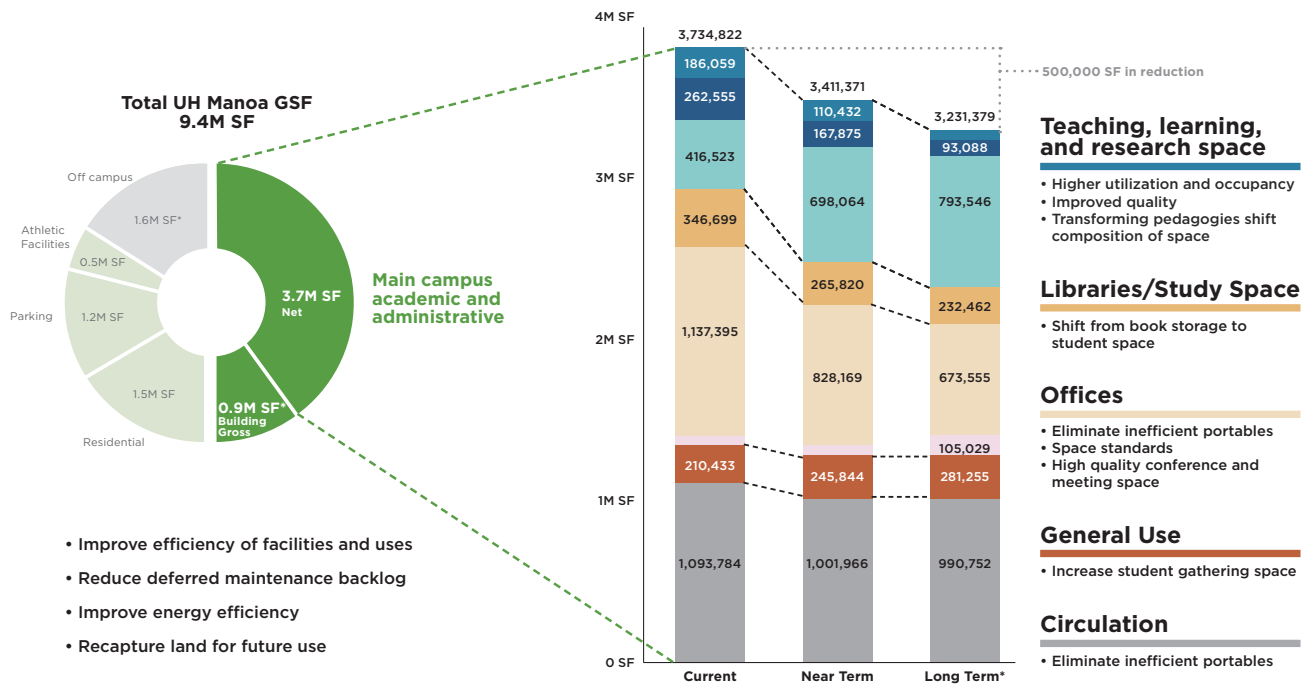

MKThink developed the Framework for the Future for the University of Hawai'i Mānoa—a set of principles, metrics, and guidelines to promote a sustainable physical campus which aligns with the university's strategies and priorities over the next 40 years.

The Framework provides the foundation for aligning campus transformation with the 100-year old university's goals: becoming a Native Hawaiian Place of Learning; enhancing student success; excellence in research; and building a sustainable and resilient campus environment.

MKThink also works with the University of Hawai'i on specific capital improvement projects designed to fulfill the goals of the Framework, and supports planning efforts across the entire 10-campus University of Hawai'i system.



BASELINE UTILIZATION STUDY Database captures details on facility use and provides the foundation for scenario modeling and data-driven prioritization of capital improvement projects.



HEAT MAPPING Sensors installed throughout the campus detect wi-fi-enabled devices to track movement patterns on campus. An online, map-based feedback forum allows the community to provide qualitative feedback on the campus experience.
